SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, **I**, the said **Robert Harrison, of Greenville County, South Carolina**  
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, **am** well and truly indebted to  
**The Woodside National Bank**  
in the full and just sum of **Twenty nine hundred (\$2900.00)**  
Dollars, to be paid **October 15, 1927**

with interest thereon, from **maturity** at the rate of **8** per cent, per annum, to be  
computed and paid **semi-annually**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

**ten per cent (10%)** besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That **I**, the said **Robert Harrison**  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

**The Woodside National Bank**  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to **me**, the said

**Robert Harrison**  
in hand well and truly paid by the said

**The Woodside National Bank**  
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, regained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **The Woodside National Bank, All that certain piece, parcel or**

**tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville in Fairview Township on Reedy River and known as the "Harrison Home Tract" or "Tract A", containing one hundred forty four (144) and 5/100 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:**

**Beginning at a box alder on the bank of Reedy River and running thence North 49-1/4 deg. East 31.08 chains to asweet-gum; thence North 50 deg. East 28.8 chains to a stake at the corner of tract "B"; thence North 43-3/4 deg. West 25.00 chains to a red oak XIII on Harrison Bridge Road; thence South 50 deg. West 35.00 chains to Sycamore on the bank of Reedy River; thence with the meanderings and old run of said River to a box alder, the beginning corner as shown by a plat or survey of the land of the Estate of J. Edward Harrison, deceased, made by F.J.-Rogers in July 1911, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in surveyor's book "A" at page 524-525 and 526.**

**This is the same tract of land heretofore conveyed to Robert Harrison by deed of J.W. Gray, Master, dated November 9, 1911 and recorded in Book 14, at page 32 in same R.M.C. Office reference to which is hereby made in aid of, and as a part of this description.**
