

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 168360

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by J. J. League to The Prudential Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated February 8, 1926 and recorded in said County on February 19, 1926, in Volume 171 of mortgages on Page 23, in the sum of Twenty Four Hundred Sixty & no/100 Dollars, with interest from February 8, 1931, and,

WHEREAS, title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Florence Nightingale League subject to said mortgage and,

WHEREAS, the said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the said J. J. League and Florence Nightingale League hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars February 8, 1932; One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars February 8, 1933; One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars February 8, 1934; One Hundred Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars February 8, 1935; and Eighteen Hundred Twenty (\$1820.00) Dollars on February 8, 1936; with interest thereon from February 8, 1931, to February 8, 1936, at the rate of six (6%) per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make additional payments on the principal sum of the note in sums of \$100.00 or multiples thereof, on any interest maturity date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
