with interest thereon, from Jan. 1 1929 until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of such debt to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, which may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of seven per cent. per annum, to be added thereto, and the same to be collectible as a debt, and the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collectible by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto as will more fully appear.)

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville, on the north side of East Carle Street, being designated on our plat of Stope Land Company, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds to-wit: - Beginning at iron pin on north side of East Carle Street, said pin being 130 feet 8 inches west of Bennett corner, and running thence n. 14-30. E. 147 feet 10 inches to iron pin on south side of Swiss Avenue; thence along south side of Swiss Avenue, n. 66-15- W. 65 feet 8 inches to iron pin; thence S. 18-30 W. 15-0 feet to iron pin on north side of East Carle Street; thence with north side of East Carle Street, S. 71-20 E. 65 feet 4 inches to beginning corner.
