All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville and State aforesaid, about four miles from the City of Greenville, near Woods Crossing on the road leading from Woods Crossing to Lawndes Hill and being known and designated as tract No. 1, of the Estate of Amanda Poole, as shown on a sub-division and plat of same made by R. E. Dalton, C. E. June, 1923, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Lawndes Hill Road, corner of land of Robert Wickliffe, running thence with the line of Robert Wickliffe land, S. 45.25 E. 561 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 2, thence with line of said lot N. 34.40 E. 205.3 feet to a stake in center of a sixteen foot road and in line of Tract No. 2; thence with line of tract No. 2, and in the center of said road N. 55.20 W. 553 feet to an iron pin in the middle of Lawndes Hill road; thence along the center of said road in a southwesterly direction 110 feet to the beginning corner and containing two acres more or less, and being a part of land owned by Johnson Poole at the time of his death.
