WHEREAS, *I*, the said *S. B. Francis*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Twenty-two hundred (\$2200.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *five* per cent, per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent (10%)*  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *S. B. Francis*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Mrs. A. M. Bairy*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *S. B. Francis*

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *Mrs. A. M. Bairy*:

*All that lot of land situate on the corner of Sullivan and Douglass Streets, in the city and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at iron pin on the north side of Sullivan Street, and runs thence with said Street 5-8 feet to a stake; thence along Douglass Street n. 10.10 E. 101 feet to an iron; thence S. 87.32 E. 50 feet to iron; thence n. 2.30 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to Joseph Sarkies by J. C. Milford by deed dated the 25th day of September, 1920, and recorded in Vol. 71 page 159, subject to the right of city. The premises herein conveyed are the same as conveyed to me by E. Dunsan, Master, by deed dated July 9, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 128 page 198.*
