TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

*G. L. Muckenfuss of Dorchester County, S.C.*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *G. L. Muckenfuss*, in and by my certain obligation for *one thousand dollars* note in writing, of even date with these presents, *and I am well and truly indebted to Susan C. Gallivan* in the full and just sum of *one thousand three hundred and three dollars*, to be paid *five years after date hereof* with the privilege of paying down any amount less than half of his loan, the holder debt, spreading the same over the sum of *one thousand three hundred and three dollars* by a division of such sum into six months in a *date thereof*, the rate of *5 1/2 per cent. per annum* to be computed and paid *semi-annually*.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent and one-half percent due* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN THAT, the said *G. L. Muckenfuss*, for in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Susan C. Gallivan*, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of *one hundred dollars*, to me, the said *G. L. Muckenfuss*, in hand well and truly paid by the said *Susan C. Gallivan*,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Susan C. Gallivan*, her heirs and assigns:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the East side of Main Street, between Washington and Coffee Streets, in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, having a frontage of twenty-five (25) feet on Main Street, with a depth along parallel lines, of eighty-five (85) feet to an alley in the rear, upon which there is a frontage of twenty-five (25) feet. Bounded on the North by lot now or formerly of *J. C. Stark*; on the East by said Alley; on the South, by lot, now or formerly of *Mrs. A. S. Duncan* and on the West by Main Street; and, being the same lot aforesaid property conveyed to *G. L. Muckenfuss* by *Nettie F. A. Symmes*, by deed dated August 31st, A. D. 1896 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. C.C.C., at page 233, and the same lot devised to me by my father, *G. L. Muckenfuss*, in his Will, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

For Value Received, I hereby sell, assign and transfer the within Note and Mortgage to *Mary Louise Bannon and Jessie McCall Gallivan, Trustees for Frances McCall Gallivan*, without recourse on me.
