may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

his heirs and assigns forever,
All that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville
Greenville County, South Carolina, described as follows:
Beginning left (50) feet from the corner of North
Street on the West side of Laurens Street; thence
running in an easterly direction with the
line of the Estes lot; parallel with North Street
98 feet to an alley; thence with alley in a north-
erly direction parallel with Laurens Street 49 1/2
feet to Manie Dacus lot; thence with Dacus
line westerly parallel with North Street 98 feet
to Laurens Street; thence with Laurens Street south-
erly 49 1/2 feet to beginning corner, being the same
land which was conveyed to me, the said Viola
