*I Robert R. Bishop*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Robert R. Bishop*  
in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*Anna M. and Eunice J. Andrea*  
in the full and just sum of *seventeen hundred & no/100*  
Dollars, to be paid *two years after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *semi*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *seventeen percent* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT the said *Robert R. Bishop*,  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Anna M. and Eunice J. Andrea*  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to *me*, the said

*Robert R. Bishop* in hand well and truly paid by the said *Anna M. and Eunice J. Andrea*  
at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Anna M. and Eunice J. Andrea*:

*All that certain parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the North side of the Spartanburg Road, and being the same designated as Lot 7 on plat of the property of Overbrook Land Company which is on file in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, page 251-252, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:*

*Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the Spartanburg Road at Southeast corner of Lot 6 and running thence with line of said Lot 6 N. 48-32 E. 200.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 45-33 E. 205.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-19 E. 52.7 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot 8; thence along line of Lot 8 S. 48-34 E. 234.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of the Spartanburg Road, also corner of Lot 8; thence along North side of Spartanburg Road S. 41-28 E. 73.5 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to by Overbrook Land Company by deed dated November 28, 1921, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 74, page 18.*
