Being about three miles from Greenville Courthouse containing 9-90/100 acres, more or less. Beginning at a stake on old line and running thence S. 88 1/2 W. 11.88 chs. to stake 3 1/2 com on Reedy River; thence down and with the meanderings of said river 8.00 chains to stake 3 1/2 com; thence N. 88 1/2 E. 11.85 chains to stake; thence N. 5 3/4 E. 8.00 chs. to the beginning corner; being the same land conveyed to me by W. J. Edgings by deed dated March 30, 1927, and recorded in R.P.C. office for Greenville County in Volume 108, at page 530.

There is no mortgage, lien or encumbrance of any kind upon the above described land.
