TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, Lee Gilliam, the said Lee Gilliam, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 17th day of December 1929, indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 17th day of December A. D. 1929 according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said Lee Gilliam shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of December 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Five & 54/100 (\$5.54) Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 3 1/2 Shares of Stock, and Five & 2/100 (\$2.04) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five & 13/100 (\$5.13) Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One & 27/100 (\$1.27) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Four & 72/100 (\$4.72) Dollars, (\$3.157) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One & 22/100 (\$1.22) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Four & 32/100 (\$4.32) Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 82/100 (\$0.82) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Three & 91/100 (\$3.91) Dollars, (\$3.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 41/100 (\$0.41) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 3 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made. me the said

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Lee Gilliam in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Lee Gilliam the said Lee Gilliam in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars the said Lee Gilliam in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the signing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville, beginning on Brier Street, at corner of said lot; thence with Brier Street N. 40 feet to a stake corner James Brier lot, thence with Brier's lot 113 feet to N. 6 Cleveland line; thence S. 9 3/4 N. 40 feet to Seawright old corner; thence with Seawright line 102 feet to the beginning corner.
