On the west side of White Horse Road (Washington Avenue) about three miles west of Greenville Court House, known as lots 8 and 9 on plat of Looper Yown property, made by Garrett & Dill, C. E., February 28, 1922, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on White Horse Road 865 feet from the intersection of White Horse Road and Easley Bridge Road, and running thence with White Horse Road in a northerly direction 100 feet to corner of lot No. 10; thence in a westerly direction 350 feet to corner; thence in a line parallel with White Horse Road 100 feet to corner of lot No. 7; thence in an easterly direction 350 feet to the beginning corner.
