with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually.

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate on principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent., besides costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said

Frank L. and Mary Willis Buxton
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number Six, according to a map or plat of a subdivision made by J. E. Serrine for Emily and Elizabeth Jones, which plat is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 8 at Page 38, reference to which is hereby made; said lot of land being described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the south line of East Avenue, the same being at the point of intersection of the East line of Lot Number six with the south line of said East Avenue, and running thence south 13 deg. 45 min. East along the line between Lots Six and Seven a distance of Two Hundred Eight (208) feet to a stake on the south line of said Lot Six, thence south 76 deg. 15 min. West Sixty-four (64) feet to a stake, thence North 13 deg. 45 min. West Two Hundred Eleven and Five Tenths (211.5) feet along the line between lots Five and Six to the south line of East Avenue, thence North 80 deg. 15 min. East along said south line of East Avenue, Sixty-four (64) feet to the place of beginning. This being the same lot of land conveyed by Henry P. Mc Gee to D. P. Montgomery by deed recorded in Book 66 Page 308 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; and being the same lot of land conveyed by D. P. Montgomery to Farmers Loan and Trust Company by deed recorded in Book 103 at Page 62 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference to which deeds is hereby made as a part of this description.
