east fork of Thompson's Beaver Dam Creek, Beginning at a  
stone  $\frac{3}{4}$  on said creek and running thence N.  $87\frac{1}{2}$  W.  $9.440$   
to a stone  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; thence S.  $5.64$  to a stone  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; thence S.  
 $77\frac{1}{2}$  W.  $6.77$  to a stone  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; thence S.  $4E. 20.04$  to a stone  
 $\frac{3}{4}$ ; thence S.  $37E. 10.96$  to a red oak tree  $\frac{3}{4}$ ; thence S.
