computed and paid *annually* *8* per cent. per annum to be

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *H. A. Bridges*,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a stone R. M. Gresham's old corner and running thence S. 44 1/2 W. 20.95 to a stone in road; thence S. 52 3/8 E. 9.65 to stone; thence S. 45 1/2 W. 3.42 to a P. O.; thence 13 3/4 W. 27.30 to stone; thence S. 56 3/4 W. 15.03 to stone; thence S. 80 E. 7.85 to the beginning corner and containing ninety-seven acres more or less and being the same land this day conveyed to me by deed of H.
