SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, Edith Tabor, the said Edith Tabor, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Bug Norris

in the full and just sum of Three Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$350.00) Dollars, Dollars, to be paid one year after date,

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8% per cent. per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may rue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in hand well and truly paid by the said Edith Tabor, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bug Norris, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Old Harris Settlement Road just off the Easley Bridge Road about three miles from Greenville Court House, being part of lot No. 28, and now known as lot No. 4, subdivided by C. M. Furman, Jr., Plat not recorded, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 3, running thence N. 21 W. 136 feet with line of lot No. 3, thence 55 feet to the corner of Lot No. 5, thence with line of lot No. 5, 125 feet to the old Harris Settlement Road, thence with the Old Settlement Road 60 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by H. P. McGee, by deed dated May 27, 1926, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 107, Page 353.

On the above described land there is situate a four room house, my present home, and this mortgage constitutes a first lien on the premises.
