Martinin consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. C. Gibson, Jr. as Committee for Henry A. Gibson

all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as tract no 3 of the survey made March 9, 1905 by E. H. McCullough of my mother's place and described as follows: Beginning at a stone 34 m. corner of lot no 2, and running thence with line of lot no 1 N. 13 E. 5.91 to a stone 34 m., thence N. 86 W. 20.68 to stone on, thence S. 2.45 W. 5.91 to corner of lot no 2, thence S. 85 W. 19.71 with line of lot no 2 to the beginning corner containing 11.60 acres, more or less. This is the same tract of land conveyed to W. M. Martin by Lilly M. Young by deed dated March 20, 1919 and recorded in Vol 34, page 520.

Also, all that other parcel or tract of land known and designated as Tract no 2 of survey made March 9, 1905 by E. H. McCullough of our mother's Place, containing 11.60 acres, more or less, and having the following metes, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stone 34 m. corner of tract no 1 owned by Lilly M. Young and running thence N. 13 E. 6.09 to stone 34 m., corner of tract no 3 (opposite to above) 34 m., corner of tract no 3 owned by Dora S. Martin; thence N. 86 W. 20.68 to stone 34 m., thence S. 2.45 W. 5.91 to stone on, thence with original line S. 86 E. 18.60 to the beginning corner. Being the same tract of land conveyed to W. M.
