Dollars, to be paid \$200.00 on the 1st day of April, 1936 and the sum of \$200.00 on the 1st day of each and every consecutive month thereafter until the full amount is paid.

with interest thereon from date & a at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually on the 1st day of January and July.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note or the mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on West side of Wilton St. Ward One, City of Greenville, in State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point 200 feet south of the southwest corner of Wilton and Randall Streets and running thence N. 1-41 E. 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ ft. to a stake on West side of Wilton St., corner of lot now or formerly owned by J. D. Neal; thence N. 83-13 W. 200 feet to a stake; thence in a line parallel with Wilton St. S. 1-41 W. 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ feet to a stake; thence S. 83-13 E. 200 feet to the beginning point on Wilton St. and being the same property conveyed to M. J. Barton by R. A. Ellicson by deed dated Sept. 11, 1926 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 118 at page 484. The said M. J. Barton having conveyed a one-half interest in the above described property to Eula Barton by deed dated Sept. 11, 1926 and recorded in Deed Book 119 at Page 217.

Beginning at a point 200 feet south of the southwest corner of Wilton and Randall Sts. and running thence N. 83-13 W. 200 feet to a stake; thence in a line parallel with Wilton St. S. 1-41 W. 8 feet to a stake; thence S. 83-13 E. 200 feet to a stake on Wilton St.; thence with Wilton St. N. 1-41 E. 8 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed by C. G. Myche on April 30, 1934.

Also: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid, on the West side of Wilton St. in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville and being more particularly described as follows:
