until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of less than one per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the old Piedmont road and running thence N. 45.50 E. 100 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 54.21. 469.50 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 83.21. 188 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 63.75 21. 66 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. one half 21. 86.40 to an iron pin, thence S. 73.75 21. 462 ft. to an iron pin on south bank of small branch, thence S. 42 E. 205 ft. to an iron pin, thence S. 49 E. 257 ft. to an iron pin, thence N. 68.50 E. 404.50 ft. to an iron pin, thence S. 54 E. 468.50 ft. to the beginning corner and containing four and seven tenths acres, more or less being a part of the land conveyed to P. M. Huff, by R. B. Gresham.
