Beginning at a stake on the south side of Stewart Street, at the corner of lot no. 14 (which stake is 360 feet from the intersection of Stewart and Mitchell Streets) and running thence with the line of Lot no. 14 S. 26-30 E. 165 feet to a stake at the joint corner of lots 4 and 5, 13 and 14, thence with the line of Lot no. 4 S. 63-35 21. 60 feet to a stake at the joint corners of lots 3, 4, 12 and 13, thence with the line of Lot no. 12 N. 26-30 21. 165 feet to a stake on Stewart Street, thence along the line of Stewart Street N. 63-35 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
