

J. A. Blakely's line 13.20 chains to an iron pin; thence south 13 degrees west 6.91 chains to a stone; thence south 59 degrees 15 minutes east 3.97 chains to an iron pin; thence south 63 degrees 39 minutes east 17.71 chains to a point; thence north 25 degrees 30 minutes east 2.42 chains to a stone; thence north 6 degrees 15 minutes west along J. M. Blakely's line 15.09 chains to a stone; thence north 41 degrees 55 minutes west 13.54 chains to a corner in road; thence north 61 degrees west 2.27 chains to the beginning corner. The last two lines divide the tract of land here conveyed from other lands of the estate of Mary E. Blakely. The tract here conveyed, according to a plat of W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated March 6, 1934, and amended October 7, 1938, contains Thirty Three and $\frac{69}{100}$ (33.69) acres, more or less, and is bounded on the north by other lands of the estate of Mary E. Blakely; on the east by lands of J. M. Blakely; on the south by lands of Waldrep and Hammond and on the west by lands of Campbell and J. A. Blakely.

Provided, However, that the security of the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as described in the security instrument hereinbefore first referred to and the security of Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, as described in the second security instrument hereinabove mentioned shall, in all respects, except as to the premises hereinbefore described, be preserved and protected and that the liens of said security instruments, except as hereby released and discharged, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants thereof and of the respective notes thereby secured shall remain unchanged.
