premium and expense of such insurance under this mortgage, with interest.

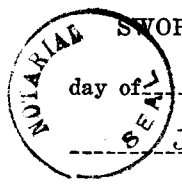
And if at any time any part of said debt, or interest thereon, be past due and unpaid, I hereby assign the rents and profits of the above described
