I, Charles H. Cely, of Greenville County, South Carolina, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said Charles H. Cely

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of

Thirty-Eight Hundred & no. 100 3800.00 Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Thirty-Two & 07/100

(\$32.07) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, on the eastern side of Melville Avenue, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 9 on plat of Westervelt Subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J" at page 13, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Melville Avenue, corner of Lot No. 8, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 68-13 E. 248.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-04 W. 62.5 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 10; thence with the line of said lot N. 68-39 W. 230.5 feet to an iron pin on Melville Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Melville Avenue, N. 17-47 E. 62.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to Charles H. Cely by Melville Westervelt, Sarah C. Westervelt, and Nade W. Calmes by deed dated September 30, 1938, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "206" at page 143.
