I, Gladys M. Martin

WHEREAS, I the said Gladys M. Martin

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to SOUTHEASTERN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Thirty-five Hundred and No/100 (\$ 3,500.00) DOLLARS, to be paid at its Home Office in Greenville, S. C., together with interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of five and one-half (5 1/2 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest being payable in monthly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 13th day of August, 1949, and on the 13th day of each month thereafter the sum of \$ 38.01, to be applied on the interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to including the 13th day of June, 1949, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 13th day of July, 1949; the aforesaid monthly payments of \$ 38.01 each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of five and one-half (5 1/2 %) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 3,500.00 or so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each monthly payment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part thereof, as therein provided, the same shall bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any condition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, and its maturity should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, and before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including (10%) percent of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

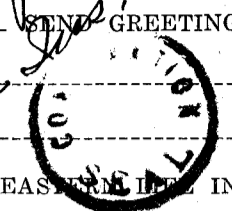

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the West side of East North Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot No. 20 on plat of property of Annie Griffin, et al, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January, 1929, and having, according to said plat, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book H, at pages 178 and 179, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of East North street, which iron pin is 57.3 feet South from the Southwest corner of the intersection of East North Street and Richland Avenue and running thence with the line of Lot No. 19, N. 75-57 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-03 W. 58 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 21 S. 75-57 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the West side of East North Street; thence with the West side of the said East North Street N. 14-03 E. 58 feet to the point of beginning.
