SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said W. A. Skelton

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of

TWO THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$ 2,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

TWENTY AND NO/100

(\$ 20.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for (10%) per centum and besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Greenville Township, situate on the south side of Bynum street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 16, as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, at pages 198-199, and according to said plat, being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Bynum street at corner of Lot No. 17, which point is 317 feet west of the intersection of said Bynum street with National Highway No. 29, and running thence along the line of Bynum street, N. 53-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 15; thence along the line of Lot 15, S. 35 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-30 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot 17; thence along line of said Lot 17, N. 35 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by Lillie Pace McBrayer by deed dated Dec. 2, 1938 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 207, page 172."
