being known and designated as Tract No. 7 according to plat of property of the T. E. Green Estate, which Plat is duly recorded in Plat Book H, page 250, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and contains 12.47 Acres, more or less, and is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a bridge in the center of the road leading from McCarter's Shop to Paris Station, and running thence with the center of said road N. 18-19 E. 400 feet to stake; thence N. 10 E. 500 feet to stake; thence N. 1-47 E. 400 feet to stake; thence N. 6-33 W. 160 feet to stake, center of said road; thence S. 70-02 W. 859 feet to iron pin; thence S. 41-54 E. 481.5 feet to the spring; thence S. 87-20 E. 59.4 feet to iron pin; thence S. 2-06 W. 328 feet to iron pin in Brushy Creek; thence with said Creek S. 60-15 E. 86 feet; thence S. 27-41 E. 125 feet; thence S. 7-55 E. 220 feet; thence S. 41-19 E. 104 feet to the beginning. The above is one of the same tracts of land conveyed by me to Lula B. Green, et al by deed dated November 18, 1934, and recorded in Deed Book 179, page 226, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
