in and by ~~xxx~~ our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, ~~xx~~ are well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of One thousand five hundred & no/100

(\$ 1,500.00) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Fifteen & no/100
