Brockman, Surveyor, dated February 8, 1940, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Pine Street and Westmoreland Avenue, and running thence along Westmoreland Avenue S. 70.00 E. 95 feet to an iron pin, corner of Minnie M.
