BEGINNING at a stake on the N. E. Corner of Parkwood Ave., and Woodbine Road  
200 feet East of said intersection and running thence, along Woodbine Road N. 71-24 E.  
60 feet to a stake; thence still along Woodbine Road N. 54-45 E. 60 feet to a stake;  
corner of Lot No. 64; thence, with line of Lot No. 64 N. 40-37 W. 134.3 feet to a stake
