organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Twenty-Six Hundred & No/100 Dollars (\$ 2,600.00), with interest from date at the rate of four and one-half centum (4½ %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of Southeastern Life Insurance Company in Greenville, S. C. or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Sixteen & 46/100 Dollars (\$ 16.46), commencing on the first day of September , 141 , and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of August, 19 61.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Oak and Wood Streets, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as ot No. 19 of Block A on Map of Woodville Heights, made by W. J. Riddle, Engineer, December, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, at pages 14 and 15, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made August 12, 1941, by W. J. Riddle, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Oak and Wood Streets, and running thence with the South side of Oak Street, N. 73-10 E. 65.6 feet to an iron pin on said Street, the joint front corner of Lots No. 18 and 19 of Block A; thence with the line of Lot No. 18, S. 9-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-10 W. 65.6 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Wood Street; thence with the East side of Wood Street, N. 9-00 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, it successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
