

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE—G.R.E.M. 2

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, **Romayne Barnes** SEND GREETINGS:
Whereas, **I** the said **Romayne Barnes**
in and by **MY** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these presents, **AM**
well and truly indebted to **J. W. Norwood, Jr.,**

in the full and just sum of **Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) & no/100**
(\$ _____) Dollars, to be paid **on or before one year from date**

with interest thereon from **date** at the rate of **six** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually in advance** until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **J. W. Norwood, Jr.**

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 31 as shown on plat of property of Estate of T. Q. Donaldson made by Dalton & Neves in April 1935, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", Page 284, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Eastern side of McPherson Street, joint Western corner of Lots Nos. 31 and 32; running thence with McPherson Street S. 11-55 W. 71 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79-58 E. 163 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-16 E. 71 feet to an iron pin, joint Eastern corner of Lots Nos. 31 and 32; thence along the dividing line of said lots N. 79-58 W. 161 feet to the point of beginning.
