, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send(s) greetings:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

**Southeastern Life Insurance Company**

, a corporation

organized and existing under the laws of **South Carolina**

called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **Two Thousand Four Hundred** Dollars (\$ **2,400.00** ), with interest from date at the rate of **four and one-half** per centum ( **4½** %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of **Southeastern Life Insurance Company** in **Greenville, S. C.** or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of **Fifteen and 19/100** Dollars (\$ **15.19** ), commencing on the first day of **November**, 19 **41**, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of **October** 19 **61**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of **Greenville**, State of South Carolina:

**All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the south side of Oak Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 17 of Block A on plat of Woodville Heights made by W. J. Riddle December, 1940, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book L, pages 14 and 15, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by W. J. Riddle, September 15, 1941, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:**

**BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Oak Street, joint corner of lots No. 17 and 18 of Block A, said pin being 126.2 feet in an easterly direction from the southeast corner of Oak Street and Wood Street, and running thence with the south side of Oak Street N. 73-10 E. 60.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 16 S. 9-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin thence S. 73-10 W. 60.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 18 N. 9-00 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Oak Street, the beginning corner.**
