All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive, partly within and partly outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of Parkview, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June 1, 1942, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, at page 49, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, October 16, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive at joint front corner of Lots No. 3 and 4, said pin also being 373 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Morningside Drive intersects with the Northeast side of Neely Drive, and running thence along the Southeast side of Morningside Drive, N. 53° 43' E. 50 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots No. 2 and 3; thence with the line of Lot No. 2, S. 36° 17' E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53° 43' W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 4 N. 36° 17' W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Morningside Drive, the beginning corner.
