all that tract or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

All those two certain lots or parcels of land lying and being situate on the North side of the Buncombe Road near the Village of Travelers Rest in the County and State aforesaid in a subdivision known as "Love Estates" as shown on a plat in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in plat book I at pages 111 and 112 and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 39 and 40. The lots are separately described by courses and distances as follows to wit:

Lot No. 39 begins at a corner on the North Bank of the Buncombe Road on lot No. 38 and runs thence along said Road N. 53-39 E. 100 feet to corner on lot No. 40; thence along the joint line of lots 39 and 40 N. 36-21 W. 200 feet to corner on lot 64; thence along the joint line of lots 39 and 64 S. 53-39 W. 100 feet to lot No. 38; thence along the joint line of lots 38 and 39 S. 36-21 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 40 begins on the North Bank of the Buncombe Road at corner of lots 39 and 40 and runs thence along said Road N. 53-39 E. 100 feet to corner on lot 31; thence along joint line of 40 and 41 N. 36-21 W. 200 feet to corner on lot 65; thence S. 53-39 W. 100 feet to corner on lot 39; thence along the joint line of lots 39 and 40 S. 36-21 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

These two lots are this day being conveyed by W. Raymond Williams Jr. as Trustee to J. D. Vaughn and this obligation is made to secure a balance due on the purchase price.
