We, **Nannie A. Johnson and Mollie L. Johnson**

Whereas, **we** the said **Nannie A. Johnson and Mollie L. Johnson** SEND GREETINGS:
in and by **our** certain **premissory** note in writing, of even date with these presents, **are**
well and truly indebted to **Mary A. Johnson**

in the full and just sum of **One Thousand and No/100**
(\$ 1,000.00 Dollars to be paid **One (1) year after date**

with interest thereon from **date** **June 18, 1946** at the rate of **5** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually**

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, that **we** the said **Nannie A. Johnson and Mollie L. Johnson,**
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof
to the said **Mary A. Johnson**

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of **Three Dollars, to US**
the said **Nannie A. Johnson and Mollie L. Johnson**
in hand well and truly paid by the said **Mary A. Johnson**

receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mary A. Johnson, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, fronting on the south side of Grove Street and beginning at a point on said Street, Fifty (50) feet from the intersection of Judson Street (the Mrs. Nora Johnson corner), and running thence along Grove Street, Fifty (50) feet to corner of Lot No. 12; thence along the line of Lots Nos. 12 and 25 to a point One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet from Grove Street; thence in a line parallel to Grove Street, Fifty (50) feet to line of Lot No. 27; thence along line of Lots Nos. 27 and 14, One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet to Grove Street, the beginning corner; being the whole of Lot Number Thirteen (No. 13) and a part of Lot Number Twenty Six (No. 26), as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book "A", page 225, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. This being the same lands conveyed to us this day by Thos. Cornelius Holland and Lucius L. Holland, by their deed to be recorded.
