E. Robinson as Trustee

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the Township of Greenville, in a subdivision of land known as the "Park Place", just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, plat of same recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 119, and known and designated as Lot No. 2 in Block D thereon. The said Lot fronting 50 feet on the Paris Mountain (New Buncombe) Road, and running back in parallel lines to a depth of 150 feet.
