in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Alfred F. Burgess

all that tract or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as shown by plat dated September 18, 1942, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, attached hereto and made a part of this deed, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake in the Blackberry Valley Road and running thence S. 43 W. 469 feet to a stake in the Blackberry Valley Road; thence S. 47 E. 615 feet to a stake in center of branch; thence N. 28-30 E. 490 feet along the meanderings of the branch to a stake in the branch; thence N. 47 W. 476 feet to the beginning corner, containing five (5) acres, more or less, this being the same land conveyed to me by C. G. Wyche by deed dated September 30, 1942, and recorded in the Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 248, Page 4.
