RELEASE

McKoy, which iron pin is in the line of property of River Mill and is located 250 feet in a northwesterly direction from Westfield Street, and running thence N. 61-43 W. 375 feet 8 inches, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S. 23 W. 672 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the northeast side of Birnie Street; thence with the northeast side of said Street S. 62½ E. 131 feet to a stone; thence still with said Street S. 74¼ E. 29 feet 3 inches to a stake; thence still with said Street S. 84½ E. 97 feet 8 inches to a stake; thence still with said Street S. 81½ E. 27 feet 8 inches to a stone; thence still with said Street N. 85½ E. 97 feet 8 inches to a stake; thence still with said Street N. 81½ E. 36 feet 2 inches to an iron pin; thence still with said Street, N. 70-3/4 E. 155 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Westfield Street; thence with the northwest side of Westfield Street N. 29 E. 20 feet, more or less, to an iron pin at the southeast corner of the lot heretofore conveyed by W. H. Austin to A. E. Morris and H. B. McKoy; thence with the line of said lot N. 61-43 W. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-42 E. 360 feet to the beginning corner.

It being understood that the said mortgage of Liberty Life Insurance Company, referred to above, shall continue as a lien on all other property described in said mortgage except the property particularly described above.
