MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, M. A. Ward and Georgia H. Ward

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Two Thousand & No/100 - - - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 2000.00 ), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & one-half (5 1/2) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, and being known and designated as Lot No. 39 of the property of Eliza T. Looper as shown on plat prepared by R. E. Dalton in December, 1924, recorded in Plat Book H at Page 159, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest corner and at the intersection of Wilson Street and Looper Street, and running thence with the West side of Looper Street, S. 9-18 E. 152 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 40; thence with the line of Lot No. 40, S. 71-20 W. 43.2 feet to iron pin, rear corner of Lot No. 38 on line of Lot No. 40; thence with the line of Lot No. 38, N. 18-40 W. 150 feet to the South side of Wilson Street; thence with the South side of Wilson Street, N. 71-20 E. 67.5 feet to the beginning corner."

Said premises being one of the lots conveyed to the mortgagors by Eliza T. Looper by deed dated October 3, 1945 and recorded in Volume 281 at Page 212.
