C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 309 of the Dukeland Park Property of the Colonia Company, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at pages 190 and 191, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of the Franklin road at the corner of Lot No. 310, which point is 148.8 feet north of the intersection of Franklin Road and Parker Road, sometimes referred to as the Tindal road, and running thence along the east side of said Franklin road, N. 43-11 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 308; thence along the line of said Lot No. 308, N. 45-24 E. 271 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the west side of Parker or Tindal road; thence along the line of said Parker road, S. 14-05 E. 134.5 feet, more or less, to the corner of Lot No. 310, on the west side of said road; thence along the line of said Lot No. 310, S. 49-49 W. 206 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot conveyed to me by J. L. Hall by deed dated July 18th, 1945 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 278, page 51."
