MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, W. E. Suttles

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

Three Thousand and No/100 DOLLARS (\$ 3,000.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of five & one-half per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Western side of Ladson Street, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being shown as Lot No. 31 on plat of property of Mrs. H. D. Wilkins, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1924, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at Page 209, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Ladson Street, 126.72 feet Northward from the North side of Otis Street, and running thence along Ladson Street, N. 11-57 W. 63.36 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast corner of Lot No. 30; thence along the line of the last mentioned lot S. 72 W. 157.5 feet to an iron pin on Hill Street; thence along Hill Street S. 2-44 E. 65.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest corner of Lot No. 34; thence N. 72 E. 168 feet along the line of Lots Nos. 34 and 32 to the beginning corner."
