TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Lois Fortner  
..... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Southern side of Pendleton Street, in the Town of West Greenville, being the Eastern portion of Lot No. 1, Block F, on Plat of the Melville Land Company recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at Page 97, and, according to a survey made by G. A. Ellis on January 10, 1947, is described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Southwestern corner of Pendleton Street and Mason Street, and running thence with the Southern side of Pendleton Street N. 66-15 W. 77.5 feet to a stake on an 8-foot alley; thence with the Eastern side of said alley, S. 44-30 W. 52.5 feet to a stake on Burdette Street; thence with the Northern side of Burdette Street, S. 46-15 E. 73 feet to a stake at corner of Mason Street; thence with the Western side of Mason Street, N. 43-45 E. 76.5 feet to the beginning corner."
