We, Thomas D. Whitmire, Jr., and Elizabeth S. Whitmire SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS We the said Thomas D. Whitmire, Jr., and Elizabeth S. Whitmire

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100

(\$ 3,000.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of TWENTY-THREE AND NO/100

(\$ 23.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Thomas D. Whitmire, Jr. and Elizabeth S. Whitmire

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me us the said Thomas D. Whitmire, Jr. and Elizabeth S. Whitmire

Patrick, which point is 20 feet west of the corner of Lot No. 12 of Block A, and running thence along the line of the Patrick lot, S. 9-52 W. 190 feet to an iron pin on the north side of a 15-foot alley; thence along the line of said alley, N. 80-08 W. 65 feet to an iron pin at the ~~rear~~ corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Mrs. Carver, which point is 15 feet east of the corner of Lot No. 14, of Block A; thence along the line of that lot, N.9-52 E. 190 feet to an iron pin on the south side of West Hillcrest Drive, which pin is 15 feet east of the corner of said Lot No. 14, of Block A; thence along the south side of West Hillcrest Drive, S.80-08 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
