MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, E. F. Day and Mary Elizabeth Day  
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Twenty-Six Hundred Fifty and No/100 DOLLARS (\$ 2650.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, known as a part of the land conveyed ot Lela S. Hodgess from E. Inman, Master, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Parker Road, and running thence with said Road N. 26 W. 1.62 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 65 E. 2.71 chains to an iron pin on Wynn's line; thence S. 31 E. 1.62 chains to Carl Ferguson's corner; thence S. 56 1/2 W. 2.82 chains to the beginning corner.
