"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the Northern side of Oak Street, and being shown as a portion of Lots Nos. 7, 8 and 9 as shown on plat of Woodville Heights, in Block C, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "L" at Pages 14 and 15, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds,

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Oak Street, which pin is 60 feet East of the joint corner of Lets Nos. 7 and 8, and running thence N. 16-50 W. 160 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence with the line of Lot No. 10, N. 2-15 E. 14 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 10; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 7, S. 73-10 W. 65.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-50 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on Oak Street; thence with the Northern side of Oak Street, N. 73-10 E. 65 feet to the point of beginning."
