19 48, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of May , 1973.

Now, Know All Men, that the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina;

All that lot of land in Gantt Township, at the Northwest corner of Hillcrest Drive and Berry Street near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 58 on plat of property of C. O. Berry, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "M" at Page 29, and also shown as Lot No. 3 on plat of property of C. B. McWhite and Ella McWhite, made by W. J. Riddle in June, 1947, recorded in Plat Book "N" at Page 135, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake at the Northwest corner of Hillcrest Drive and Berry Street, and running thence with the North side of Hillcrest Drive, S. 89-50 W. 129.5 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 59; thence with the line of said lot, N. 3-45 E. 156.5 feet to a stake on Berry Street; thence with the Western side of Berry Street, S. 37-40 E. 195.7 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being the same conveyed to the mortgagors by C. B. McWhite by deed dated June 14, 1947, recorded in Book of Deeds 313 at Page 368.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all the buildings, walks, fences, shrubbery, driveways, improvements and fixtures of every kind, including stoves, refrigerators, ranges, cabinets, venetian blinds, heaters, boilers, radiators, engines, machines, motors, screens, blinds, doors, hardware, wires, switches, electric fixtures, bells, insulations, and all other water, plumbing, ventilating, and heating equipment, including stokers, oil burners, tanks, air conditioning equipment now upon or which may hereafter be placed upon said property, shall be deemed to be fixtures and part of the realty herein conveyed, and shall be deemed part of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned, and shall be covered by this mortgage.
