All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles from the Greenville County Courthouse and being known and designated as lots 1 to 8 inclusive, as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February 1948, for Ruth Mauldin and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
