SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said **Vantross Franklin**
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, **am** well and truly indebted to **Jas. M. RICHARDSON, attorney**
in the full and just sum of **One Hundred Thirty Five Dollars (\$135.00)**
to be paid **November 1, 1949**

with interest thereon from **date**
at the rate of **six** per centum per annum, to be computed and paid **semi-annually**
until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at same rate as principal: and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Jas. M. Richardson, attorney
All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in the
City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, at the corner of
Leach and Dunbar Streets, having a dwelling located thereon and be-
ing one of the three lots conveyed to G. C. Franklin by W. H. Irvine
by deed dated November 7, 1912, recorded in Deed Book 16, Page 66,
R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, and being the last parcel of land
described in a deed from G. C. Franklin to Vantross Franklin by
deed dated December 27, 1940, recorded in Deed Book 229, Page 371,
R. M. C. Office, Greenville County.

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is inferior in
rank to one given by Vantross Franklin to the said **Jas. M. Richardson,**
