MORTGAGE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, **D. L. Lamb and Mae F. Lamb**, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto **The Bank of Travelers Rest**,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of -----

----- **Seven Hundred and No/100** ----- DOLLARS (\$700.00),
with interest thereon from date at the rate of **six (6%)** per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: **Principal due one year after date, with interest payable semi-annually**

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in **Greenville Township, on the western side of Fletcher Street (formerly Hunt Street), near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 22 of Block A on plat of Sunny Slope, made by R. E. Dalton in May 1919, recorded in Plat Book F at Page 86, and described as follows:**

Beginning at a stake on the western side of Fletcher Street, 415.3 ft. north from Agnew Avenue, at corner of Lot No. 24, and running thence with line of said lot N. 80-12 W. 150 ft. to stake at corner of Lot No. 21; thence with line of said lot N. 9-48 E. 52 feet to stake at corner of Lot No. 20; thence with line of said lot S. 80-12 E. 150 feet to stake on Fletcher Street; thence with the western side of Fletcher Street S. 9-48 W. 52 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by J. Frank Williams by deed to be recorded herewith."
