have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward One of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of the Ava O. Ferguson lands according to a plat of the same prepared by Will D. Neves, Surveyor, on March 22, 1915, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, at page 254, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at the joint front corners of Lots 8 and 9, and running thence along the West side of Wilton street, N. 13-30 E. 57.5 feet to the joint front corners of Lots 9 and 10; thence along the line of Lot 10, N. 76-30 W. 150 feet to a point on the rear line of Lot 19; thence S. 13-30 W. 57.5 feet to a point on the rear line of Lot 18; thence along the line of Lot No. 8, S. 76-30 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
