a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Seventy-five Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$ 7,500.00), with interest from date at the rate of four per centum (4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Thirty-nine and 59/100 Dollars (\$ 39.59), commencing on the first day of October, 19 49, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of September, 19 74.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville, Gantt Township, State of South Carolina; being known and designated as Lot No. 228, according

to plat of Section A of the property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, which plat was made by the Piedmont Engineering Service on August 29, 1949, and which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following described bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Fox Hall Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 227 and 228 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 227 N. 60-42 W. 147.1 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 228; thence along the line of Lot No. 228 S. 1-30 W. 147.1 feet to an iron pin on North Beaver Lane; thence along North Beaver Lane S. 73-31 E. 88.7 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of North Beaver Lane and Fox Hall Road; thence in a curved line, the chord of which is N. 32-54 E. 30 feet to an iron pin on Fox Hall Road; thence along Fox Hall Road N. 25-54 E. 85 feet to the point of beginning.

Together with all and singular the improvements thereon and the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining; all the rents, issues, and profits thereof (provided, however, that the Mortgagor shall be entitled to collect and retain the said rents, issues, and profits until default hereunder); all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the premises herein described and in addition thereto the following described household appliances, which are and shall be deemed to be, fixtures and a part of the realty and are a portion of the security for the indebtedness herein mentioned; Electric hot water heater, floor furnace, storage tank and
